- In a total of 339 matches, River scored 589 goals and conceded 300. It has an average of 1.74 goals for and 0.88 goals against per game. It has managed to keep a clean sheet in 139 matches.
- Marcelo Gallardo coached 136 home games at the Monumental Stadium:
  75 wins, 37 draws, and 24 losses. He managed to keep a 17-match unbeaten streak at all the tournaments (10 wins and 7 draws) between February and November 2016.
- River has won twelve titles since Gallardo's arrival. On average, it has lifted one trophy every 213 days.

• Throughout his seven years in River, Gallardo has used 111 players, out of which 41 (36.9%) were youth players whom he made play professionally for the first time. Two of these youth players have played over 100 games for River: Gonzalo Montiel (132) and Lucas Martínez Quarta (104). The only player who has played over 200 matches under Gallardo's management is Leonardo Ponzio (204). Ponzio and Jonatan Maidana are the only players who have been part of the current professional team since its debut against Ferro for the Argentine Cup.

 There are nine River players who have played more than 10,000 minutes under Gallardo's management. All of them also played in the historic match against Boca, at the Santiago Bernabéu Stadium, in the 2018 CONMEBOL Libertadores final. Seven of them are still River players.

- Franco Armani is the goalkeeper with the most games without conceding goals under Gallardo's management: he kept a streak of six matches without conceding goals, considering all tournaments, between May and July 2018 (4W 2D).
- Gallardo keeps a positive record at all the tournaments where River has played against its four historic rivals: Boca, Independiente, Racing, and San Lorenzo. Furthermore, River has played against the four of them at international tournaments and won every single one of those play-off rounds.

The rival Gallardo has faced the most as River manager is Boca Juniors. The teams have faced off 22 times, taking all tournaments into account, and River keeps a positive record regarding the super classic match: seven wins, ten draws, and five losses. It has also played 15 games against Godoy Cruz and Rosario Central.

 Guillermo Barros Schelotto is the coach Gallardo has faced the most as River manager. They faced off in eleven games, out of which River won four, drew five, and lost two. Three out of the five managers he has faced the most have coached (or coach) Boca: Guillermo Barros Schelotto (2016-2018), Gustavo Alfaro (2019), and Miguel Ángel Russo (2020 - present).

## RIVER AND GALLARDO AT THE CONMEBOL LIBERTADORES

 Gallardo is the manager who has won the most CONMEBOL Libertadores titles in the Club's history, having won two. He is also the manager who has played the most finals (3) and the one who has coached the most games. El Muñeco has won 37 games, drawn 28, and lost 14.

 Ignacio Fernández is the player who has made the most assists playing for River at the CONMEBOL Libertadores: ten of his passes were converted to goals for el Millonario. Gonzalo Montiel and Matías Suárez come in second place, tied on 9 assists.

 Ignacio Fernández is the player who has made the most contributions playing for River at the CONMEBOL Libertadores in the Gallardo era: he made 21 contributions, with 11 goals and 10 assists.

- While coaching River, Gallardo has won at least one away game playing abroad for the CONMEBOL Libertadores in each of the countries that are part of the Confederation, except for Bolivia. In total, he has won 13 away games at the tournament. He won the most in Brazil (3): Cruzeiro in 2015, Grêmio in 2018, and Palmeiras in 2020.
- River is on an unbeaten streak of eight CONMEBOL Libertadores matches played in Brazil (2W 6D). Since Gallardo's arrival, River has won more games in Brazil than it has won in all its history taking part in the tournament.
- River is the team that has scored the most goals at the CONMEBOL Libertadores since Gallardo's arrival (139) and ranks third in terms of average goals per game amongst teams that have played more than 15 matches (1.76).

- 59% of the goals (80) were scored in the second half.
- Since Gallardo began coaching River, el Millonario has scored 26% (36) of its goals at the CONMEBOL Libertadores in the last 15 minutes of the match. Furthermore, it is the only team that has scored in extra time: Juan Fernando Quintero and Gonzalo Martínez, in the final of the 2018 edition, against Boca Juniors at the Santiago Bernabéu Stadium.
- River is the only team that has scored eight goals in a CONMEBOL Libertadores quarterfinal match (8-0 against Jorge Wilstermann at the 2017 edition) and the only one that has done it twice, as it also scored eight goals playing against Binacional in 2020. Since then, no other club has scored eight goals in a match at the continental tournament.

# RIVER AND GALLARDO, THE RECORD AND OTHER TOURNAMENTS

River has played six Recopa matches under Gallardo's management and has only lost one game (4W 1D 1L). It has won the three games it played at the Monumental Stadium and it has been crowned champion every time it took part in the tournament.

River has lost only one game at the Argentine Cup since Gallardo became its coach: it has played 30 games, winning 24, drawing 5 (it was eliminated in two penalty shootouts) and only losing in the 90 minutes against Rosario Central in the 2015 edition. El Muñeco has won three editions of the tournament: 2016, 2017, and 2019. River keeps a streak of 24 matches without losing in the 90 minutes.

Ignacio Scocco is the River player who has scored the most goals in one match under Gallardo's management: he celebrated five goals in the 8-0 win over Jorge Wilstermann.

Marcelo Barovero is the goalkeeper who has made the most saves in one match to keep a clean sheet under Gallardo's management: he made eight saves against San Lorenzo in the 2014 Recopa rematch. That night, River won 1-0 and lifted the trophy.

On September 18th, 2019, in the match against Godoy Cruz for the Argentine Cup (1-0), River broke several records in the Gallardo era: it had an average ball possession of 81%, it made 787 passes and 678 of them were accurate (Gallardo-era highs in both cases).

River's match against Binacional became the match with the highest number of shots on goal in the Gallardo era, with 17 shots. In the 4-1 win over Independiente at the 2014 Initial Tournament, River scored three goals from outside the box: it was the match with the highest number of long-range shots in the Gallardo era.

Marcelo Gallardo faced Boca Juniors in six playoff series, including two finals, winning the first five consecutively and losing only one, in the penalty shootout, after the 90 minutes ended in a draw.
